The Police Mobile Rural Contact Point is a vital link between the Police, Council Services and Rural Communities, specifically designed for residents who live in an area without a council building or police station to hopefully make communities feel less isolated by bringing services directly to them.

It will be staffed by a Police Officer and a Nottinghamshire County Council Contact Advisor, who can provide advice and information on Social Services, welfare rights, Blue Badge Scheme, schools, free school meals, traffic and travel, employment opportunities, housing, Council Tax, environment services, crime prevention, driving enquiries, reporting crime and incidents, lost and found property and general enquiries.

It also has wheelchair access and a private interview room for anyone who wishes to speak to a police officer or county contact advisor confidentially. So why not go along and find out more.
