

THE MOBILE RURAL CONTACT POINT

The Mobile Rural Contact Point is a vital link between the Police, Council Services and Rural Communities, specifically designed for residents who live in an area without a council building or police station to hopefully make communities feel less isolated by bringing services directly to them.

The contact point is staffed by a Police staff member and a Nottinghamshire County Council County Contact advisor who provide advice and information on social services, welfare rights, blue badge scheme, schools, free school meals, traffic and travel, employment opportunities, housing, council tax, environment services, crime prevention, driving enquiries, reporting crime/incidents, lost and found property and general enquiries.

It also offers wheelchair access and a private interview room for anybody who wants to speak to a police officer or county contact advisor confidentially. So why not go along to find out more and make use of this facility
